

After 6 hours of the course delivery, you will need to gain 10 hours in a placement to complete the full award certification.



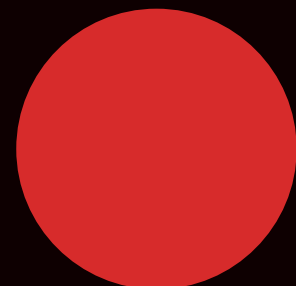

The Award is practically delivered workshop with resource booklet to be completed to gain certification.





Scenario based and highlighting what and how to support best practice in your placement aiding understanding and confidence to enable safeguarding support.







Ideal for those working in Community, Sport, Clubs, School Sport, Holiday Provision, Disability and Inclusion programmes.

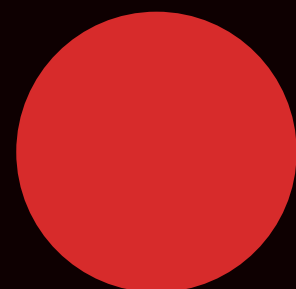



Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (RQF) – 8 Hours Workshop and Practical - £75

The **Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981** require all employers to ensure their employees receive immediate attention if they are injured or taken ill at work. Having the correct first aid provision in place is not only a legal requirement but also essential for workplace safety.

The **Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (RQF)** is designed for individuals who wish to act as designated first aiders in their workplace. This comprehensive one day course equips candidates with the essential skills and knowledge to manage a wide range of injuries and illnesses that may occur at work.



As a **regulated qualification**, this course enables employers to meet their legal obligations for first aid training without the need for lengthy due diligence checks.

- CPR and defibrillation
- Managing an unresponsive casualty
- Recovery Position

Makaton Level 1 – 6 Hours - £100 Workshop Delivery

Makaton Level 1 is the starting point for learning the Makaton Language Programme, which uses signs, symbols, and speech to support communication.

This foundational course introduces the core principles and provides practical skills for using Makaton in everyday situations.

Participants learn the signs and symbols for Stages 1 and 2 and some from the Additional stage of the Makaton Core Vocabulary.

Ideal for those working in Disability and Education based SEND environments.

OTHER COURSES

Mental Health First Aid - 3 Hours - 16+ - £40 Workshop delivery

This course teaches you to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental ill health in others, similar to how physical first aid works.

These courses provide individuals with the skills to offer initial support, encourage professional help-seeking, and create a supportive environment.
